APPRENTICESHIP RECRUITMENT Oahu Registration

The Honolulu Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee (JATC) for the Plumbing & Pipefitting Industry will be establishing waiting lists for the Plumber, Refrigeration Air Conditioning, Fire Sprinkler Fitter, and Steamfitter Welder apprenticeship programs on the island of Oahu. TIME: 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Each applicant must meet the following MINIMUM qualifications:

a. Be not less than seventeen (17) years of age.

b. Have a valid driver's license.

Each applicant must meet the following SPECIFIC qualifications:

- a. Provide evidence of being a high school graduate or have a General Educational Development (G.E.D.) certificate or equivalent.
- b. Provide "official" transcript of high school records, and transcript of trade school courses, if any.
- c. Take a Placement Evaluation test and satisfactorily pass with a minimum score of 70-percent.
- d. If Applicable, provide validated previous experience.

<u>Applicants may apply for only one (1) program</u> and must pay an application fee of \$20.00 at the time of applying. Make checks payable to: PAMCAH-UA Local 675 Training Fund. Any returned checks will be charged a \$20.00 handling fee and applications will be withheld from further processing until full payment has been made.

If accepted as an apprentice, an agreement for each year of apprenticeship training (called a *Scholarship Loan Agreement*) which provides that you will reimburse the JATC for the cost of training if you perform plumbing, pipefitting, refrigeration air conditioning, fire sprinkler, or steamfitter-welder work for a contractor who has not signed a collective bargaining agreement with UA Local 675, must be signed.

All required documents (high school diploma or G.E.D., high school transcript, post high school trade courses (if any), valid driver's license) must be received by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, February 7, 2014.

Men and women meeting the above minimum and specific qualifications will be interviewed and may be placed as eligible applicants on the waiting list. The waiting lists will consist of twenty-five (25) applicants each from which the JATC may select to become apprentices in the Plumber, Refrigeration Air Conditioning, Fire Sprinkler Fitter, and Steamfitter Welder programs.

The Joint Apprenticeship & Training Committee has adopted an affirmative action plan. They have pledged that the recruitment, selection, employment, and training of apprentices during their apprenticeship shall be without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, physical handicap, marital status, or arrest and court record which does not have a substantial relationship to the functions and responsibilities of the prospective or continued employment, provided that a sponsor may refuse to refer for employment an individual for good cause relating to the ability of the individual to perform the work. Affirmative action shall be undertaken to provide equal employment opportunity in apprenticeship and the apprenticeship program shall be operated as required under Chapter 31, Title 12, Administrative Rules.
