Applicants must meet minimum qualifications for apprenticeship as listed below:

- Be a minimum of 18 years of age. **Must provide document to verify age requirement (such as a copy of applicant's birth certificate or State drivers license or State ID card, etc.).**
- Provide copy of high school diploma or GED, as well as all applicable **official** transcripts and records.
- Show evidence of successful completion of one full year of high school Algebra 1 or higher math and/or successfully complete the National Joint Apprenticeship & Training Committee (NJATC) Tech Math Course (provide official transcript). - Pass the NJATC Aptitude Test with a minimum score established by the JAC.

Other requirements:

- Pay an Application Fee of \$25.00 (**non-refundable**) at time of application. **Money Order or Cashier's Check** made payable to: **Hawaii Electricians Training Fund.** **No personal check or CASH.**
- Must provide four (4) self-addressed, stamped envelopes (No. 10 size – 4 1/8" x 9 1/2") with postage ("**Forever**" stamps are preferred).
- Must pass a substance abuse test prior to indenturing.
- Must become a member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Union 1186 when you become an indentured apprentice.
- Term of apprenticeship program shall be on the island of Maui.

The recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices during the apprenticeship shall be without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex or age, except the applicant must be at least 18 years of age to apply and be indentured.
