The Hawaii Laborers' Apprenticeship Program is now accepting applications for persons looking for work in Hawaii's growing construction industry.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPRENTICESHIP

- 1) Applicant shall be not less than eighteen (18) years of age and may be required to show proof.
- 2) Applicant shall possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent *preferred*, or be able to show proof of at least a 10th grade education.
- 3) Applicant shall possess a valid driver's license when submitting an application and at the start of the Pre-Construction Evaluation course.
