

# OAHU OPEN RECRUITMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICE LABORERS



The Hawaii Laborers' Apprenticeship Program is now accepting applications for persons looking for work in Hawaii's growing construction industry.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPRENTICESHIP

- 1) Applicant shall be not less than eighteen (18) years of age and may be required to show proof.
- 2) Applicant shall possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent *preferred*, or be able to show proof of at least a 10th grade education.
- 3) Applicant shall possess a valid driver's license when submitting an application and at the start of the Pre-Construction Evaluation course.

### Required Documents

(required to have with you when applying – original documents only)

#### Valid Drivers License

High School Diploma or GED equivalent (preferred) or proof of completion of 10<sup>th</sup> grade education

(Acceptable documents: High school transcript, Letter from high school (must be on school letterhead) stating person did graduate with date of graduation, Military discharge paper (DD214), College transcript or diploma)

(Unacceptable documents: Printable copies from website, Photo copies)

***Apprenticeship wages begin at \$16.65 an hour***

Journey Worker wages are \$30.70 - \$33.30 an hour plus fringe benefits that total \$47.71 - \$50.31 an hour, after completion of the two year apprenticeship program.
