Applicants must meet minimum qualifications for apprenticeship as listed below:

- Be a minimum of 16 years of age. Provide copy of ID document (such as a copy of applicant's birth certificate or State drivers license or State ID card).
- Have completed the twelfth (12th) grade of school or equivalent, or successfully have passed the GED. Provide copy of high school diploma or GED, as well as all applicable official transcripts and records showing evidences of successful completion of one full year of high school Algebra 1 or higher math and/or successfully completing the National Joint Apprenticeship & Training Committee (NJATC) Tech Math Course (<http://www.njatc.utk.edu/techmath.htm>).
- Pass the NJATC Aptitude Test with a minimum score established by the JAC. To view a sample test go to (<http://www.electricaltrainingalliance.org/SamplePage>)

Other requirements:

- Pay an Application Fee of \$25.00 (non-refundable) at time of application. Cashier's Check, Money Order made payable to: Hawaii Electricians Training Fund. **NO PERSONAL CHECK OR CASH – THANK YOU!**
- Must provide four (4) self-addressed, stamped envelopes (No. 10 size – 4 1/8" x 9 1/2") with postage stamp of \$0.49. ("Forever" stamp is preferred)
- Must pass a substance abuse test prior to indenturing.
- Must become a member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Union 1186 when you become an indentured apprentice.
- Term of apprenticeship program shall be on the island of Maui.

The recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices during the apprenticeship shall be without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex or age, except the applicant must be at least 16 years of age to apply and be indentured.
