\*\* OSHA will retain regulatory responsibility over private maritime activities, federal government employers and workers and contractors or subcontractors where the land is under exclusive federal jurisdiction (national parks, military bases), and over postal operations.

**BENCHMARKED POSITIONS**

HIOSH will need to adequately maintain 9 safety and 9 health inspectors as well as the necessary managerial positions (safety supervisor, safety manager and health manager). Currently, all those positions are filled with the exception of the safety manager that is under recruitment. In addition, OSHA also requires 4 Consultation & Training staff, which are also currently filled.
