#### Work-Related Incidents To Be Reported

You must report work-related incidents resulting in:

- 1. Death
- 2. Inpatient hospitalization of one or more employees
- 3. Any amputation or loss of an eye
- 4. Any property damage in excess of \$25,000

#### **<u>Time Frame To Report The Incident</u>**

- 1. Deaths must be reported within eight (8) hours after the incident
- 2. All other reportable incidents listed above must be reported within twenty four (24) hours after the work-related incident

### How To Report The Incident

Incidents must be reported by calling (808) 586-9102, or in person at the HIOSH Office in Honolulu All of the following information must be provided:

- 1. The company name
- 2. The location of the work-related incident
- 3. The time of the work-related incident
- 4. The type of reportable event
- 5. The number of employees who suffered a fatality, inpatient hospitalization, amputation or loss of an eye
- 6. Estimate of property damage in excess of \$25,000
- 7. The company contact person and his/her phone number
- 8. A brief description of the work-related incident
