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## CERTIFICATION OF SCRAPPED, REPLACED OR DISCONTINUED ELEVATOR

Hawaii Administrative Rule (HAR) §12-229-7.1 requires that when elevators and related equipment are to no longer be used, the owner or user must notify the department. In addition, the entrances must be permanently barricaded and the power mechanism disabled. Elevators with hoisting ropes must have the hoisting ropes removed and the car and counterweights brought to the bottom of the hoistway. Plunger type elevators must have the liquid line to the plunger disconnected. Prior to placing the elevator or related equipment back into service, the department must be notified and an inspection to permit its use be made.

Normally, anytime an elevator or related equipment is out of service for longer than one month, it must be rendered inoperable as above until a subsequent inspection by the department finds that the equipment is safe to operate.
