This is the thirty-sixth annual informational bulletin issued by the Hawaii Labor Relations Board providing, by employing jurisdictions, the number of public employees included in each of the 13 collective bargaining units established by Hawaii Revised Statutes § 89-6(a). The figures reported are correct as of December 31, 2008.

The 13 collective bargaining units are:

- 01 Nonsupervisory employees in blue collar positions;
- 02 Supervisory employees in blue collar positions;
- 03 Nonsupervisory employees in white collar positions;
- 04 Supervisory employees in white collar positions;
- Teachers and other personnel of the department of education under the same salary schedule, including part-time employees working less than twenty hours a week who are equal to one-half of a full-time equivalent;
- Of Educational officers and other personnel of the department of education under the same salary schedule;
- 07 Faculty of the University of Hawaii and the community college system;
- O8 Personnel of the University of Hawaii and the community college system, other than faculty;
- 09 Registered professional nurses;
- 10 Institutional, health, and correctional workers;
- 11 Firefighters;
- 12 Police Officers; and
- 13 Professional and scientific employees, who cannot be included in any of the other bargaining units.
