On August 9, 2017, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) held a Pre-hearing Conference in the above reference complaint. The Pre-hearing Conference was recessed to allow the parties to engage in off-the-record discussion. Upon reconvening the Pre-hearing Conference, the Complainant, DARRELL F. FERMAHIN, indicated to the Board his decision to withdraw the Prohibited Practice Complaint (PPC,) 17-CU-01-353. The Complainant assured the Board that the decision was made based on his own free will. The Board allowed the Complainant to make an oral motion to withdraw the PPC. The Respondents, UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO and CHARLIE LEE HOWARD, through their counsel had no objection to the Complainant's motion to withdraw the PPC.

The Board granted the Complainant's Motion to Withdraw the Prohibited Practice Complaint. Therefore, the PPC is dismissed and the case is closed.
