## ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING ON THE MERITS SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 15, 2018

On August 1, 2018, HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME Local 152, AFL-CIO (Complainant) and DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, STATE OF HAWAII (Respondent) filed with the HAWAII LABOR RELATIONS BOARD (Board) JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING ON THE MERITS SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 15, 2018 (Joint Motion) requesting that the scheduled hearing on the merits be continued.

On August 1, 2018, the Respondent filed RESPONDENT DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, STATE OF HAWAII'S MOTION TO DISMISS COMPLAINANT'S PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT. Pursuant to Board Order No. 3376, the Complainant has until August 8, 2018 to respond to the dispositive motion. Further, Board Order No. 3376 set forth a pretrial conference and oral arguments on dispositive motions to be held on August 13, 2018, at 9:00 am, in the Board's Hearing Room, 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii.

The Board HEREBY GRANTS the Joint Motion for good cause shown and amends Section (5) NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE MERITS of Order No. 3376 by removing the scheduled hearing on August 15, 2018 from the calendar. During the Pretrial Conference to be held on August 13, 2018, as previously ordered, the Board will seek the parties' waiver of the forty-day requirement to hold the hearing on the merits in this matter, and reset a new date for the hearing on the merits. All other sections of Order 3376 remain in effect.
