# DECISION AND ORDER

This occupational safety and health case is before the Board on a written contest by A & K Nursery and Flowers of the Director's citation and notification of proposed penalty issued on January 28, 1980. The citation charges that on January 15, 1980 the company violated Section 103.2-1 of the State Occupational Safety and Health Standards by failing to maintain a log of all recordable occupational injuries and illnesses (OSHA No. 200 form) at the establishment.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

On January 15, 1980, employer, A & K Nursery and Flowers failed to maintain a log of all recordable occupational injuries and illnesses (OSHA No. 200 form) or its equivalent at the establishment.

## CONCLUSION OF LAW

Employer A & K Nursery and Flowers violated

Section 103.2-1 of the State Occupational Safety and Health

Standards.

## ORDER

The citation and proposed penalty issued on January 28, 1980 relative to violation 103.2-1 is hereby affirmed. A & K Nursery and Flowers is hereby ordered to pay the amount of \$50.00.
