### DECISION AND ORDER

This occupational safety and health case is before the Board on appeal by Responent, HAWAII COUNTY ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY COUNCIL, from the Citation and Notification of Penalty issued by the Administrator of the Division of the Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH), Department of Labor and Industrial Relations on August 4, 1992.

The sole issue is whether the amount of the proposed amended penalties, which total \$5,600.00, for violations of Standards §§12-60-2(a)(3), 12-79-3(h), 12-80-4(h)(3), 12-80-5(b)(10), 12-89-5(f)(4), 12-89-6(b)(2), and 12-51-2(a)(1) is appropriate.

### FINDINGS OF FACT

 Respondent, HAWAII COUNTY ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY COUNCIL, is a private non-profit organization whose income is dependent on public funds.

2. The hazards cited by DOSH were promptly abated.

# CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

We conclude that a penalty of \$1,000.00 for the above noted violations is appropriate in this case.
