ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE; AND NOTICE OF HEARING

Respondent ALOHA ROOFING filed the instant Notice of Contest on or about June 22, 2005. Thereafter, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued a Notice of Initial Conference on July 5, 2005 scheduling an initial conference in this matter on July 26, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. The Notice of Initial Conference stated, "THE APPEALING PARTY'S FAILURE TO ATTEND THIS INITIAL CONFERENCE MAY BE GROUNDS FOR DISMISSAL OF THE APPEAL."

On July 26, 2005, Complainant's counsel appeared before the Board at the designated time for the initial conference. Respondent's representative failed to appear at the designated time. The Board also noted that Respondent had not filed an Initial Conference Statement prior to the conference. Complainant's counsel thereupon orally moved for an order of dismissal based upon Respondent's failure to prosecute this contest.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby issues this ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE to Respondent ALOHA ROOFING to participate in a hearing scheduled on August 26, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. in the Board's hearing room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, to show cause and explain why this case should not be dismissed, with prejudice, for lack of prosecution. If Respondent fails to appear in the Board's hearing room to participate in the scheduled hearing and establish good cause, the Board will dismiss the case for lack of prosecution. If Respondent files its initial conference statement and establishes good cause why this case should not be dismissed, the Board will proceed to conduct the initial conference in this case on August 26, 2005.
