ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT TINE TUIOLEMOTU'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On September 21, 2015, Complainant TINE TUIOLEMOTU (Complainant) filed a prohibited practice complaint (Case No. CE-10-868) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) against Respondent DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, Oahu Community Correctional Center, State of Hawaii (Respondent).

On October 30, 2015, Complainant delivered to the Board a letter which stated in part as follows: "This letter is to inform you that I am requesting to withdraw my complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board. I have chosen to go through the U.S. Department of Labor instead."

The Board shall accept Complainant's letter and treat his request as a motion to withdraw his prohibited practice compliant (Motion to Withdraw).

Section 12-42-44 of the Board's Rules states in part:

Section 12-42-44 Withdrawal. Any complaint may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final order thereon, upon motion and with the consent of the board. Whenever the board approves withdrawal of such complaint, the case shall be closed.

With the filing of the Motion to Withdraw, Complainant has met the first two of the three requirements of Section 12-42-44, and the sole issue before this Board is whether to consent to or reject Complainant's request to withdraw the prohibited practice complaint.

There being no reason to deny Complainant's withdrawal request, the Board hereby approves the withdrawal of the complaint filed in Case No. CE-10-868. This case is closed.
