ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S ORAL MOTION TO CONTINUE DE NOVO HEARING AND DEADLINES; NOTICE OF STATUS CONFERENCE

On January 18, 2017, Complainant filed two motions:

- 1) Director's Motion to Compel Director's First and Second Requests for Answers to Interrogatories (Motion); and
 - 2) Director's Motion to Compel Director's First Request for Production of Documents.

On February 3, 2017, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) held a motion hearing on the above motions. All parties were represented by counsel. Respondent informed the Board that the federal criminal trial was rescheduled to May 2017 and based on the Fifth Amendment of the Unites States Constitution, Respondent's employees would not answer any questions or testify on any matters related to this case until the completion of the federal criminal trial. Respondent orally moved to continue the *de novo* hearing set to begin on March 6, 2017 with the exchange of Final Exhibit Lists and Witness Lists due on February 20, 2017. The Board granted Respondent's Oral Motion over the Complainant's objection and scheduled a status conference on July 5, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. in the Board's hearing room. The parties agreed to cooperate with discovery requests after the federal criminal trial ends.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board hereby grants Respondent's oral motion to continue this case and all deadlines are continued. The *de novo* hearing scheduled for March 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 13, 2017 is canceled and all dates are taken off the calendar. All deadlines and the *de novo* hearing are continued and will be set at the July 5, 2017 status conference. DISCOVERY CUT-OFF is extended to July 21, 2017. The Complainant's motions are held in abeyance until moved on.
