## ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING IMPASSE AND APPOINTING A MEDIATOR

On April 24, 1998, the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its representative, filed a written notification to the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), that an impasse had been reached in contract negotiations for employees in bargaining unit 10 (Institutional, health and correctional workers).
