ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE

At the status conference held in this matter on April 21, 1998, the parties stipulated to dismiss the instant complaint without prejudice subject to the terms previously expressed in the hearing held in this matter on February 5, 1997 and reflected in the transcript of the hearing at page 140. There, the parties agreed to resolve as many of the issues as they possibly could in connection with the custodian handbook and are operating under the principle that matters covered by the collective bargaining agreement would be kept out of the handbook. Matters that are not covered by the collective bargaining agreement and are operational, and other matters would be part of the handbook. The parties also agreed to submit areas of disagreement on whether the matter is negotiable to the Board for determination.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby dismisses the instant complaint without prejudice.
