ORDER GRANTING STEPHEN YAMASHIRO'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSE TO UPW'S MOTION TO DISMISS FILED ON JUNE 9. 1999

June 1999, Petitioner STEPHEN (YAMASHIRO), by and through his counsel, filed a motion for extension of time to file a response to the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO's (UPW) motion to dismiss with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board).
