ORDER SERVING DOCUMENTS, EXTENDING TIME TO ANSWER AND DENYING MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION

On July 9, 1979, Complainant Jeffery S. Silva wrote a letter to this Board complaining of the situation which caused him to file the above-referenced cases. Attached to said letter were a number of documents. On July 27, 1979, this Board's executive officer wrote to Mr. Silva advising him that if he wished to file a case against the UPW, he would have to use the Board's petition form. He was advised that if he wished to, he could attach his handwritten letter to the form. (A copy of the executive officer's letter is attached.) Thereafter, Mr. Silva filed his petition forms

with a new handwritten letter attached to them. The Board served the petition form and the second letter upon Respondents.

Subsequently, Respondent Matayoshi, by his attorney, filed a motion for particularization. At this time, the Board will not grant the particularization. Instead it will serve upon Respondents all of the documents, including the first letter, provided to this Board by Mr. Silva. These documents taken together would seem to satisfy the request of Hawaii County for a particularization. The service of these documents upon Respondents will extend their time to answer the Complaints herein to no later than 4:30 p.m., Tuesday, September 4, 1979.
