ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On August 3, 2018, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (Complainant) filed with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) a prohibited practice complaint (Complaint) against DAVID Y. IGE, Governor, State of Hawai'i and RODERICK BECKER, Comptroller, State of Hawai'i.

On October 26, 2018, Complainant filed Complainant's Motion to Withdrawal of Prohibited Practice Complaint (Withdrawal).

Complainant states in the Withdrawal, "The parties have resolved this matter, with each to bear its own fees and costs. The dismissal of this matter has been agreed to by the parties."

Hawai'i Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-44 Withdrawal provides, "Any complaint may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final order thereon, upon motion and with the consent of the board. Whenever the board approves withdrawal of such complaint, the case shall be closed."

HAR§ 12-42-8(g)(3)(C)(iii) requires that any response to a motion be filed "within five days after service of the motion, unless the board directs otherwise."

More than five days has elapsed since the service of the Withdrawal, and the Board has received no response.

ORDER

For the reasons given above, the Board grants the Withdrawal of the Complaint. This case is closed.
