## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE BRIEFS

On January 29, 1981, the attorney for Complainants

State of Hawaii Organization of Police Officers and Peter Toro

(hereafter Complainants) filed a request for an extension of

time to file simultaneous posthearing briefs from January 30,

1981 up to and including February 27, 1981 and if necessary and

with prior notice to the Board to file simultaneous supplementary

briefs on or before March 27, 1981.

In the affidavit in support of the motion, the attorney for Complainants states that the attorney for Respondent City and County of Honolulu (hereafter Respondent) has no objections to the extension of time.

Accordingly, the Board grants the request for extension of time to file posthearing briefs. The parties have up to and including February 27, 1981 to file posthearing briefs. With prior notice given to the Board on or before March 9, 1981, either or both of the parties may have up through March 27, 1981 to file a supplementary brief in the case. In view of the fact that the parties have already had over three months since the conclusion of the hearing on October 10, 1980 to submit posthearing briefs, no further extensions will be granted.

If the Complainants fail to submit their posthearing brief by the above-stated deadline, the case will be dismissed. If the Respondent fails to submit his posthearing brief in a timely manner, the failure to file shall be considered a waiver of the right to submit a brief.
