ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR DECLARATORY RULING

On May 29, 1981, Petitioner HAWAII NURSES ASSOCIATION, American Nurses Association, filed the instant Petition for Declaratory Ruling with this Board. Petitioner indicated therein that it had filed a Petition for Certification as the exclusive bargaining representative for bargaining unit 9 composed of registered professional nurses on or about April 30, 1981. The representation election was conducted by the Board on June 15-16, 1981 and the tally of ballots held on June 17, 1981 indicated that the majority of valid votes were cast to retain the Hawaii Government Employees' Association, AFSCME, Local 152, AFL-CIO, as the unit's bargaining representative.

Inasmuch as the concerns raised by Petitioner are premised and conditioned upon its certification as the exclusive bargaining representative, the Board finds them to be hypothetical at this point in time and not involving existing facts which can be reasonably expected to exist in the near future.

Accordingly, the Board declines to issue a declaratory order pursuant to the instant petition and hereby dismisses this case.
