ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES FOR DISPOSITION

On January 29, 1985, KEI IINUMA filed a prohibited practice complaint against GEORGE R. ARIYOSHI, alleging a violation of Subsection 89-13(a)(8), Hawaii Revised Statutes [hereinafter referred to as HRS]. Similarly, on January 29, 1985, Complainant filed a prohibited practice complaint against HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO, alleging a violation of Subsection 89-13(b)(4), HRS. The complaints arise from an unsatisfactory performance appraisal and the union's handling of the resulting grievance.

As these complaints involve substantially the same parties and issues, the Board finds that consolidation of the proceedings would be conducive to the proper dispatch of business and the ends of justice and will not unduly delay the proceedings. Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(13), these complaints and the proceedings thereon are hereby consolidated for disposition.
