## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING

On February 12, 1986, LOUIS VICTORINO, Complainant in Case Nos. CE-01-96 and CU-01-49, and Respondent in Case No. CEE-01-1, by and through legal Counsel, E. Courtney Kahr, filed a Motion to Continue Hearing with this Board. The motion requested that the Board continue the hearing in this matter which was originally scheduled for February 20, 1986 to another date.

In her supporting affidavit, Kahr stated that she has a previously scheduled court date which cannot be rescheduled and which conflicts with the Board hearing as presently scheduled.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants VICTORINO's motion for continuance of the hearing.

On February 14, 1986, the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as UPW], Respondent in Case Nos. CE-01-96 and CU-01-49, filed a Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Jurisdiction with this Board. In its supporting memorandum, the UPW argues that issues relating to the adequacy of UPW's representation of VICTORINO are outside the statute of limitations.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the hearing on the instant complaint is continued until March 6, 1986, at 10:00 a.m., in the Board's hearings room, 550 Halekauwila Street, Honolulu, Hawaii. The UPW's Motion to Dismiss will be entertained first at this hearing.

The Board directs the parties to regard subpoenas previously issued to compel the attendance of witnesses as effective for the pending hearing.
