On March 5, 1986, Respondent TONY T. KUNIMURA, Mayor of the County of Kauai, filed with this Board a Motion for Particularization of Prohibited Practice Complaint, together with a supporting affidavit.

Upon review of the aforesaid motion and affidavit and the charges set forth in the complaint, the Board concludes that particularization of the complaint as requested in Respondent's motion should be granted pursuant to Administrative Rules Section 12-42-45(b).

Complainant is hereby directed to file with this Board the original and five (5) copies of the requested particularization, with proof of service upon Respondent, no later than 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of this order. The

Particularization should specify those provisions of the applicable collective bargaining agreement which Respondent allegedly violated.

If Complainant fails to file and serve the particularization in a timely manner, the Board shall dismiss the subject prohibited practice complaint.

Respondent is hereby directed to file with this Board the original and five (5) copies of its answer, with proof of service upon Complainant, no later than 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of complainant's particularization. The failure by Respondent to file its answer in a timely manner shall constitute an admission of the material facts alleged in the complaint and particularization and waiver of a hearing.
