On January 27, 1988, the HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as HGEA], filed a Motion to Consolidate Instant Matter with Proceeding Involving Substantially the Same Parties and Issues with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board [hereinafter referred to as Board]. The motion is hereby denied in view of the possibility that the companion case, Board Case No. DR-13-47, may be withdrawn by the State of Hawaii.

At the prehearing conference held on February 16, 1988, the parties and the Board entered into certain oral agreements regarding the disposition of the instant matter. The Board hereby formalizes the agreements as follows:

The parties shall submit written stipulations of fact by March 4, 1988. Thereafter, the parties shall file written briefs on the instant matter with the Board by April 15, 1988.
