FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW,
AND ORDER

This case was initiated on June 13, 1979, when the University of Hawaii Board of Regents (hereafter BOR) petitioned this Board for the transfer of one position currently included in Unit 7 (Faculty of the University of Hawaii and community college system) to Unit 8 (Personnel of the University of Hawaii and the community college system, other than faculty).

Based upon the Petition, Affidavit of the University's Director of Administration Harold S. Masumoto, the current position description and the written consent to the position transfer obtained from the University of Hawaii Professional Assembly (hereafter UHPA) representative, this Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

The BOR is the public employer of the employees in bargaining units 7 and 8.

UHPA is the certified exclusive bargaining representative of Unit 7. The Hawaii Government Employees' Association (hereafter HGEA) is the exclusive representative of the employees in Unit 8.

UHPA concurs in the proposed transfer of the position. The HGEA has been advised of this petition and has not objected. All parties involved waive the right to a hearing thereon.

The position in question is No. 82044, Director, Publications and Information, College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources.

The BOR intends to reclassify the position and include it in Unit 8.

The duties and responsibilities of the position are stated in the current position descriptions which has been certified as accurate by the appropriate supervisor of the position.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The BOR by competent evidence has substantiated its petition, that the proposed unit change is proper and consistent with Section 89-6, HRS.

ORDER


Position No. 82044 is transferred from Unit 7 to Unit 8.
