FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSION OF LAW,  
AND ORDER

On June 13, 1979, the University of Hawaii Board of Regents (hereafter BOR) petitioned this Board for the inclusion of one position in Unit 8 (Personnel of the University of Hawaii and the community college system, other than faculty).

Based upon the petition, the Affidavit of the University's Director of Administration Harold S. Masumoto, and the position description attached to the aforementioned petition, this Board makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

Petitioner BOR is the public employer, under Subsection 89-2(9), HRS, of the employees in bargaining unit 8.

The Hawaii Government Employees' Association (hereafter HGEA) is the certified exclusive representative of all employees in Unit 8.

The HGEA concurs as to the appropriateness of the inclusion of the single position in Unit 8 as proposed by the BOR and waives a hearing thereon.

The position in question has been identified as No. 90249, Business Management Officer.

The duties and responsibilities of the position are stated in the current position descriptions which has been certified as accurate by the appropriate supervisor of the position.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

By the evidence presented, the BOR has substantiated its petition that the proposed unit change is proper and consistent with Section 89-6, HRS.

ORDER


Position No. 90249 should be included in Unit 8.

The mechanics shall be worked out between the parties to this case, provided that the effective date shall not be earlier than the date of this decision.
