months duration or less.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above-named public employer shall bargain collectively with the University of Hawaii Professional Assembly (AAUP-NEA) and enter into a written agreement with such employee organization with respect to wages, hours, and other terms and conditions of employment which are subject to negotiations under the Act.
