ORDER GRANTING INTERVENOR CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU'S REQUEST TO RECONSIDER AND WITHDRAW ITS PETITION TO INTERVENE FILED ON SEPTEMBER 5, 2003; AND NOTICE OF SECOND PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On October 13, 2003, Intervenor CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU (CITY) filed a request to reconsider and withdraw its petition to intervene filed on September 5, 2003 with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The City asserts that this dispute is between the Petitioner and the State of Hawaii and that it is not in a position to comment or argue the propriety of the State's proposed rules or Petitioner's arguments that they should have been subject to the adoption of rules.

Based on the record and the arguments presented, the Board hereby grants the CITY's request to withdraw its petition to intervene filed on September 5, 2003 for good cause shown.
