STIPULATION AND ORDER

STIPULATION AND ORDER

COMES NOW the United Public Workers, AFSCME, Local 646, AFL-CIO ("UPW" or "Union") and the County of Hawai'i ("County") and hereby stipulate to the following terms and conditions to resolve the above-entitled matter.

- 1. The UPW is an employee organization and the exclusive representative of blue collar non-supervisory employees in bargaining unit 1.
- 2. The County of Hawai'i is a public employer within the meaning of Section 89-2, Hawai'i Revised Statutes ("HRS"), which operates the Highway Maintenance Division in the Department of Public Works on the island of Hawai'i.
- 3. On or about October 1, 2004, and thereafter, the County of Hawai'i reorganized its Highway Maintenance Division by reallocating four Road Construction Maintenance Supervisor I (WS-10) positions to Road Construction Maintenance Supervisor II (FI-10) positions, and by adding 18 (eighteen) Laborer II positions.
- 4. On February 22, 2005, the UPW filed a petition for clarification and amendment of appropriate bargaining unit in RA-01-216a and RA-02-216b, in connection with position number 1158 (in the South Hilo District), position number 1740 (in the Hamakua District), position number 1244 (in the North and South Kohala District), and position number 3645 (in the North and South Kona District).
- 5. The County of Hawai'i has assured the UPW that it has no intention of reallocating or removing from bargaining unit 1 Road Construction Maintenance Supervisor I (WS-10) positions currently assigned in the Puna District (Position 3644), and in the South Hilo District (Positions 1064, 1074, and 1077), and has no intention of diminishing work opportunity to WS-10 level positions within bargaining unit 1.
- 6. In addition, the County of Hawai'i anticipates a need for additional staffing and new positions in the Highway Maintenance Division, particularly in the Puna and Hamakua Districts, due to the expansion of the County's jurisdiction over "roads in limbo" in said areas.

- 7. In order to accommodate the added increase in workload in the Highway Maintenance Division, the County of Hawai'i agrees to phase in two or more Road Construction Maintenance Supervisor I (WS-10) positions, subject to available funds and approval by the County Council.
- 8. Based on the foregoing, the UPW agrees to the placement of position numbers 1158, 1740, 1244, and 3645 into bargaining unit 2.
- 9. The parties agree that a violation of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation and Order shall constitute a prohibited practice, in violation of Section 89-13(a)(5), HRS.
