ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO DISMISS COMPLAINT FOR MOOTNESS, FILED JULY 27, 2009

July 27, 2009, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF On HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (UHPA or Union) filed a Motion to Dismiss Complaint for Mootness (Motion to Dismiss) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant's counsel states in a Declaration attached to the Motion to Dismiss that since the Complaint was filed in this matter, the parties mutually agreed to submit the issues underlying this Complaint to arbitration and in good faith expedited the hearing and decision in this matter; that the Arbitrator rendered a Decision and Award on July 20, 2009 which held that the collective bargaining agreement between UHPA and the University of Hawaii remains in force and effect; since the matters that gave rise to the Complaint have been resolved and there is no relief to be granted, the Complaint is moot and may be dismissed. Complainant's counsel also states that he has spoken with counsel for the Respondent BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii (BOR), Robert Katz, Esq., on the matter of the proposed dismissal of the Complaint and that the BOR does not object to the dismissal of the Complaint.

Based on the foregoing, the Board finds that the issues underlying the instant Complaint are moot and hereby grants Complainant's Motion to Dismiss.
