On October 5, 2010, Complainant HAWAII STATE TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (HSTA), by and through its counsel, filed a Motion to Amend Complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The HSTA proposed to amend its Prohibited Practice Complaint, filed on February 22, 2010, to clarify its claims and submit supplemental claims pursuant to testimony received by the Board during hearings in this matter.

Thereafter, on November 3, 2010, the HSTA filed a Motion for Order Granting HSTA's Motion to Amend the Complaint Filed October 5, 2010 with the Board. The HSTA moved for an order granting HSTA's Motion to Amend Complaint Filed on October 5, 2010 for lack of any timely objection to the motion from Respondents.

After review of the record, consideration of Complainant's motions and hearing no objection from Respondents, the Board in its discretion hereby grants the HSTA's Motion to Amend Complaint, Filed on October 5, 2010 and Complainant's Motion for Order Granting HSTA's Motion to Amend the Complaint Filed October 5, 2010, Filed on November 3, 2010, pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-43.
