ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENTS' SECOND MOTION TO

INTERLOCUTORY ORDER STAYING ACTION OF RESPONDENTS

On November 17, 1993, Respondents JOHN D. WAIHEE, III, Governor, State of Hawaii, and BOARD OF EDUCATION, State of Hawaii, by and through their attorney filed a motion to continue hearing on Complainant's motion for interlocutory order with the Board. 
Appropriate provisions of the notice issued on September 29, 1993 remain applicable.


