ORDER DENYING HGEA'S MOTION TO RECONSIDER ORDER GRANTING,
IN PART, RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION
AND GRANTING HGEA'S MOTION TO HOLD CASE IN ABEYANCE

On November 24, 1993, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through its counsel, filed a motion with this Board to reconsider its order, dated November 18, 1993, granting, in part, Respondent's motion for particularization. HGEA contends that the order was issued prematurely in violation of the Board's Administrative Rules. HGEA further contends that the substance of its prohibited practice complaint is contained in paragraph 9 of the complaint which is sufficiently clear for Respondent to respond to.


After considering the arguments contained in Complainant's motion and reviewing the prohibited practice complaint filed herein, the Board confirms and hereby adopts its former ruling and denies Complainant's motion to reconsider.

On December 1, 1993, Complainant HGEA, by and through its counsel, filed a motion to hold this case in abeyance until January 31, 1994 in order to permit the parties to pursue a settlement of the issues underlying the complaint. Counsel for Complainant indicates that Respondent's counsel confirms that the matter is near settlement. Complainant further requests that any particularization if ordered be due on January 31, 1994.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to hold the case in abeyance. If this matter is not settled, Complainant's particularization is due on January 31, 1994.
