ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO STIPULATION OF PARTIES

On April 19, 1994, the above-named parties submitted an Amendment to the Stipulation To Declare Certain Employees Essential Workers, dated April 17, 1994, to the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The parties agree that the employees set forth in the stipulation, are essential workers pursuant to § 89-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and are therefore prohibited from participating in a strike against the above-named Petitioner.

The Board has reviewed the subject amendment to the stipulation and finds that the positions identified by the parties are essential to protect the health and safety of the public. Accordingly, pursuant to § 89-12, HRS, the Board hereby orders that the positions identified in the Amendment to Stipulation To Declare Certain Employees Essential Workers, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference herein, are essential and are required to be staffed in order to avoid an imminent or present

danger to the health and safety of the public. The remaining provisions of the Order Approving Stipulation of Parties, dated April 17, 1994, remain in full force and effect.



AMENDMENT TO STIPULATION TO DECLARE CERTAIN
EMPLOYEES ESSENTIAL WORKERS

The HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES' ASSOCIATION, LOCAL 152,
AFSCME, AFL-CIO (hereinafter "HGEA"), and the STEPHEN K. YAMASHIRO
("County"), in accordance with the terms of the stipulation to
declare certain employees essential workers filed as Exhibit A to
the Hawaii Labor Relations Board Order No. 1041, hereby agree

to modify the number of essential workers contained therein. The HGEA and County agree that the number of Fire Radio Dispatchers will be increased by 3 so that the list of essential workers in the Fire Department will be as follows:
