Dear State employee:

There is currently pending before the Hawaii Public Employment Relations Board a case which could result in your being excluded from collective bargaining. The State of Hawaii and the HGEA have entered a stipulation which, if approved by HPERB, after an investigation and hearing, would have the effect of excluding the position you currently occupy from the collective bargaining unit. The consolidated case is designated Case No. RA-03-11, RA-04-12, and RA-13-13. Our investigation will commence at 9 a.m., Monday, March 14, in our hearings room, second floor, 550 Halekauwila Street, Honolulu.

Although the personal desires of employees concerning unit inclusions or exclusions cannot be considered by this Board, if you have facts which would tend to show that you do or do not occupy a top level managerial position or a position in which you are concerned with confidential matters affecting employeeemployer relations, the Board would appreciate it very much if you would put this information in writing and send it to us no later than Tuesday, March 15, 1977. Based upon your written statement, the Board may wish tt call you as a witness in its investigation or hearing or both.
