ORDER DENYING INTERVENOR'S MOTION TO REOPEN AND GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTION TO REOPEN

The hearing in the instant case was concluded on February 8, 1977. On February 18, 1977, the attorney for Intervenor filed a Motion to Reopen for Introduction of Evidence. Said motion is denied at this time. However, if Intervenor will provide in writing, with reasonable particularity, a showing as to what evidence he seeks to introduce upon reopening, this Board will consider granting his motion to reopen.
