ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S EX PARTE REQUEST TO RESCHEDULE HEARING; NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING

On July 27, 1994, Complainant LEWIS W. POE (POE) filed an ex parte objection to the August 10, 1994 hearing date in the instant case with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The Board treats POE's objection as a motion pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(3).


POE requests that the Board reschedule the hearing in the instant matter to approximately three or four weeks after the prehearing conference scheduled on August 3, 1994 so that he may have adequate time to properly prepare for his case. POE contends that he would be placed in an unfair position if the hearing were to proceed on August 10, 1994 because he has another hearing before the Board on the same day. POE indicates that he waives his right to a hearing on the instant complaint within forty days as provided by Administrative Rules § 12-42-46.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant's ex parte request to reschedule the hearing on the instant prohibited practice complaint. POE is directed to serve a copy of his ex parte objection and any further filings in this matter on Respondent CALVIN M. TSUDA, Deputy Director, Department of Transportation, State of Hawaii.


