ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S FIRST MOTION TO CONTINUE
HEARING ON PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT; NOTICE OF HEARING

On August 24, 1994, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its attorney, Peter Liholiho Trask, Esq., filed a motion to continue the hearing in the instant case with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Mr. Trask indicates that in preparing for the hearing in this matter, he discovered that he may be called as a witness. Therefore, Mr. Trask requests that the Board continue the hearing scheduled for Monday, August 29, 1994 until Tuesday, November 1, 1994 and Wednesday, November 2, 1994 so that he may obtain new counsel for Complainant and apprise new counsel of the circumstances of Complainant's prohibited practice complaint.

Hawaii, by and through their attorney, Francis Paul Keeno, informed the Board that Respondents do not object to Complainant's motion.

Appropriate provisions of the notice issued on May 25, 1994 remain applicable.
