EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE POST HEARING MEMORANDUM


On October 28, 1994, the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its counsel, filed a motion for a second extension of time in which to file its post hearing memorandum with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Rebecca L. Covert, Esq., states in an affidavit attached to the motion that counsel for this case Herbert R. Takahashi, Esq., was in an accident and injured his shoulder.
