ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANTS' MOTION  
TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT


On November 17, 1994, Complainants JOYCE H. KAWAKAMI; NAOMI YAMAKAWA; LITA V. ZAPATA; and HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through their principal representative, HGEA Union Agent Alton K. Watanabe (Watanabe), filed a motion to withdraw the instant prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board).

In his affidavit attached to Complainants' motion, Watanabe indicates that Complainants seek to withdraw the instant complaint because Complainants and Respondent GEORGE N. KAYA, Director, Department of Public Works and Waste Management, County of Maui, have informally resolved this matter.
