ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S SECOND REQUEST
TO CONTINUE PREHEARING CONFERENCE;
NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED SECOND PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On December 1, 1994, Complainant CHARLES R. BUNCH filed a second request to continue the prehearing conference for 90 (ninety days) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant indicates that his present medical condition relative to his surgery precludes him from participating in these matters for approximately 14 - 21 days. In addition, his treating clinical psychologist, Gentry T. Jones, Ph.D., recommends that he not participate in any legal matters for a treatment period of at least

60 days. Jones further suggests that due to BUNCH's surgical complications, the treatment period will probably be closer to 90 - 120 days.

Based upon the documents submitted and for good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant's second request to continue the second prehearing conference in this matter.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Board will conduct a second prehearing conference in this matter by conference call on March 1, 1995 at 9:00 a.m. Appropriate provisions of the notice issued on May 19, 1994 and October 21, 1994 remain applicable.
