PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE


On January 27, 1995, Complainant STATE OF HAWAII ORGANIZATION OF POLICE OFFICERS (SHOPO), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw complaint without prejudice with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The affidavit of SHOPO's counsel indicates that the parties have recently negotiated language in their collective bargaining agreement which should aid in the resolution of the issues of the subject complaint. SHOPO's counsel also indicates that the parties desire to resolve any existing problems without the Board's intervention. SHOPO's counsel further states that counsel for Respondent has no objection to this motion.

Pursuant to § 12-42-44, the Board hereby grants Complainant's withdrawal of the subject prohibited practice complaint without prejudice.
