ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW  
PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On February 2, 1995, Complainant STATE OF HAWAII ORGANIZATION OF POLICE OFFICERS (SHOPO), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw complaint without prejudice with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). SHOPO's counsel states in an affidavit supporting the motion that the parties are involved in litigation in the First Circuit Court which raises similar issues to this complaint and that the Court will likely resolve such issues. SHOPO's counsel further states that counsel for Respondents has no objections to this motion.

Pursuant to § 12-42-44, the Board hereby grants Complainant's withdrawal of the subject prohibited practice complaint without prejudice.




