ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S REQUEST
TO POSTPONE HEARING ON MOTION TO DISMISS

At the prehearing conference on January 25, 1995, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) tentatively scheduled a hearing on Respondent AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, LOCAL 928's (AFSCME) motion to dismiss for February 7, 1995 and rescheduled the hearing on the merits of the instant unfair labor practice complaint from February 7, 1995 to March 2, 1995.

Thereafter, on February 3, 1995, Complainant SALEEM AHMED (AHMED) filed a request to postpone the hearing on the motion to dismiss with the Board. In a note dated February 1, 1995 attached to his request, Complainant's physician indicates that AHMED is unable to participate in a hearing for the next thirty (30) days for medical reasons.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant's request to postpone the hearing on Respondent's

motion to dismiss. Complainant's deadline for filing a response to Respondent's Motion to Dismiss filed on January 31, 1995, the hearing on the motion to dismiss, and the hearing on the merits of the instant case are hereby continued until further notice.


