ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE


During the second status conference held on March 1, 1995, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW or Union), by and through its representative, indicated that the Union would withdraw this complaint since Respondents had agreed to resolve the matter by restoring the Heavy Truck Driver II position at the Kapaa transfer station. Thereafter, by letter dated March 6, 1995, the UPW notified the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) that the Union recently learned that the position had not been restored and additional time was necessary to restore and fill the position. As such, the Complainant requested a continuance of this case until June 1, 1995.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants UPW's request. This matter is continued until June 1, 1995.

The Board also hereby reminds Complainant that the Board's Administrative Rules require the parties to file the original and five copies of any document with the Board.


