ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO RESET HEARING;
NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED PREHEARING CONFERENCE
AND HEARING ON PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On April 17, 1995, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO, by and through its attorney, filed a Motion to Reset Hearing with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board).¹ In an affidavit attached to the motion, counsel for Complainant indicates that since December 27, 1994, the parties have been unsuccessful in their attempts to settle this dispute. Counsel for Complainant therefore states that no settlement is possible between the parties and this matter should be reset for hearing. Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to reset the hearing in this case.

¹Previously, the Board issued an order continuing the hearing scheduled for December 28, 1994 until further moved on because the parties were attempting to settle this matter. See Order No. 1136, Order Granting Respondents' Motion to Continue Hearing, dated December 27, 1994.

The parties shall file amended prehearing statements if necessary with the Board two days prior to the prehearing conference.

YOU ARE ALSO NOTIFIED that the Board will conduct a hearing on the instant complaint on May 8, 1995 at 9:00 a.m. in the above-mentioned hearings room.

Appropriate provisions of the notice issued on May 25, 1994 remain applicable.
