ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION
FOR PARTICULARIZATION OF THE COMPLAINT

On May 9, 1995, Respondent MICHAEL NAKAMURA, Chief, Honolulu Police Department, City and County of Honolulu (NAKAMURA), by and through his counsel, filed a motion for particularization with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). NAKAMURA contends that the complaint filed in this matter by CALVIN DAVID MILLER is so vague and indefinite that Respondent cannot reasonably be required to frame an answer thereto. NAKAMURA indicates that while Complainant identifies the subsections of Section 89-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), which Respondent allegedly violated, the complaint fails to set forth a clear statement of facts supporting the complaint, including specific facts as to the names, dates, times and places involved in the alleged improper acts.

After reviewing the complaint and its attached documentation, the Board agrees with Respondent that the complaint does not contain specific factual allegations to which Respondent
